- Leftover food
- Fruits and vegetables
- Coffee grounds and tea bags
- Eggshells
- Flower bouquets



All food waste must be bagged
- remember to tie the bags



- Dirty packaging
- Pizza boxes
- Crisp bags
- Gift wrap
- Nappies
- Vacuum cleaner bags
- Dog poo in a bag



All residual waste must be bagged
- remember to tie the bags



- Soft plastics e.g., plastic bags
- Plastic bottles without deposit
- Plastic trays and packaging
- Sweet bags



Must be scraped out and be drip-free



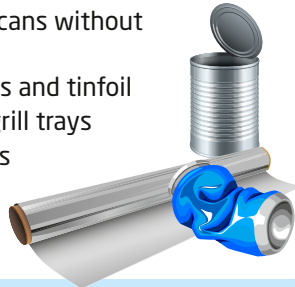
- Milk and juice cartons
- Cartons for e.g., peeled tomatoes, soup and sauce



Must be scraped out and be drip-free



- Tins
- Beer and soda cans without a deposit
- Aluminium trays and tinfoil
- Foil trays and grill trays
- Tealight holders



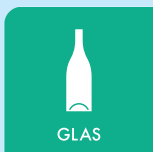
Must be scraped out and be drip-free



- Newspapers and magazines
- Advertisements
- Office paper and envelopes
- Paper bags



Must be dry and not dirty



- Glass bottles without a deposit
- Canning jars
- Drinking glasses
- Shards of glass



Must be scraped out and be drip-free



- Cardboard boxes
- Egg boxes
- Cardboard tubes
- Cardboard packaging
- Corrugated cardboard



Must be dry and not dirty



- Worn and damaged clothes, bedding, blankets, etc. that cannot be used by others
- Fabric remnants



Textile waste must be dry
and delivered in a clear
plastic bag



- Detergents
- Painting
- Small electronics
- Light bulbs
- Spray cans
- Batteries
- Nail polish



Must not contain sharp objects,
medicines or fireworks
